

ABx Bauxite Production Ramps Up to Assist Fertiliser Production

- Australian Bauxite Limited (ABx) is commencing the delivery of 800 tonnes of its special fertiliser bauxite product from its Bald Hill Bauxite Project at Campbell Town, northern Tasmania as part of an on-going contract to regularly supply bauxite to the fertiliser production plant operated by Impact Fertilisers in Hobart
- Fertiliser production is an essential industry because fertiliser is needed for food production
- Because ABx operations in Tasmania are an integral part of the supply-chain of this essential industry, ABx and contractors are permitted to continue operations during the current Corona Covid-19 crisis restrictions
- This “just in time” delivery of fertiliser grade bauxite by ABx was required by Impact before Friday 3 April because its stocks of ABx’s special bauxite product were low and production would have been curtailed, affecting its 50 direct employees, its supply of fertiliser to the agricultural industry and also interrupting Impact’s supply of a product used for fluoridation of Hobart’s water supply
- The resurgence of agricultural production in recent months due to the recent rains augers well for a strong demand for fertiliser this year
- ABx’s mine management, contractors and customers have implemented strict health safety protocols on arrival at site, during production, loading and transport to the fertiliser production facility in compliance with the national response to the Corona virus pandemic
- ABx is not planning any capital raising at this time. It continues to operate with its full workforce, whilst also adhering to restrictions imposed by the national Corona Virus (Covid-19) Pandemic Response
- The research centre operated by ABx’s 90%-owned subsidiary, Alcore Limited remains open and the technical team are assessing results from tests on its aluminium fluoride products that are being conducted by major laboratories nominated by its 3 potential customers for Alcore’s aluminium fluoride products and Corethane gas-substitute. Alcore’s technical team led by Dr Mark Cooksey have devised a series of critical experiments which will commence soon

Australian Bauxite Limited (ABx) has its first bauxite mine in Tasmania and holds the core of the Eastern Australian Bauxite Province. ABx's 12 bauxite tenements in Queensland, New South Wales & Tasmania exceed 719 km² and were selected for (1) good quality bauxite; (2) near infrastructure connected to export ports; & (3) free of socio-environmental constraints. All tenements are 100% owned, unencumbered & free of third-party royalties. ABx's discovery rate is increasing as knowledge, technology & expertise grows.

The Company's bauxite is high quality gibbsite trihydrate (THA) bauxite that can be processed into alumina at low temperature.

ABx has declared large Mineral Resources in northern NSW, southern NSW, Binjour in central QLD & in Tasmania, confirming that ABx has discovered significant bauxite deposits including some of outstandingly high quality.

At Bald Hill near Campbell Town, Tasmania, the Company's first bauxite mine commenced operations in December 2014 – the first new Australian bauxite mine for more than 35 years. ABx has created significant bauxite developments in 3 states - Queensland, New South Wales and Tasmania. Its bauxite deposits are favourably located for direct shipping of bauxite to both local and export customers.
